RESIDENT RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Policy

To safeguard the rights of persons who are residents at WDH house.

Basis

Each resident has certain rights and responsibilities to ensure the best experience possible.

Procedures

- A. Residents will be informed of their rights and responsibilities upon entry into the Women of Dignity and Honor House and be given a copy of the rules
- B. The following are the residents rights

As a resident you have the right to,

- 1. Be treated with dignity and honor
 - 2. Actively participate and make decisions in your own recovery.
 - 3. Be given accurate information prior to the start of your stay.
 - 4. Be seen by a private physician with the understanding that all costs will be the responsibility o the resident.
 - 5. Have all information pertaining to stay held in confidence.
 - 6. Receive accurate and up to date information about costs.
 - 7. Be fully informed at the time of entry of the rights and responsibilities set forth herein and of all the rules and guidelines governing resident conduct.
 - 8. Initiate a complaint of grievance procedure and understand that you may begin the grievance procedure by contacting the House Manager or any Director.
 - 9. Request referral resources in the event of your dismissal from the $\ensuremath{\mathsf{WDH}}$ house.
- 10. Not be required to perform services at the WDH house which are not standard of all residents.
